††RESIDENCY. You need a total of 17 units (500 hours) for residency. 1 unit of N415.03 = 30 clock hours. **Registration must occur during the quarter in which the residency is experienced.** You can opt to take only 8 units (240 hours) for residency if you are **not** interested in certification as a clinical nurse specialist (CNS) in California.

**NOTE!** You can take other courses at any time during matriculation that enhance your area of interest, for example, HIV/AIDS, sociology, global health, race/class, etc. You may need the instructor's permission to register for the course. **Prior to graduating, you must take one course that fits the 2-unit sociocultural requirement.**
